The Mission of the Month for September is for Midwest Mission Distribution Center. Their mission is "Bringing the hearts and hands of God's people together to transform resources into humanitarian relief." Midwest Mission serves as a logistical conduit for Christ's ministry. Requests for needed items are received from trusted nonprofits. Items needed are supplied by churches and other supporters. Donations are then shipped to trusted nonprofits who then distribute to those in crisis. Shipments are sent to both domestic and international locations. Supplies are prayed over multiple times while packed and prayer cards are included in each kit. These resources give hope and empowerment to those they reach. They work with the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) to receive, assemble, store and disburse UMCOR kits, and they work with Food For The Poor to pre-stage Disaster Relief supplies in Southern Florida and in 10 Latin American and Caribbean countries.
