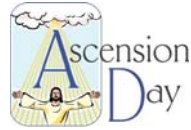

The **Transport for Christ Mobile Chapel** located at the Petro Travel Plaza in Rochelle turns 20 this year, so it's time for a new chapel trailer! Costs for converting a trailer into a chapel will be at least \$20,000.

Petro has committed to assist in fundraising for this project and are coordinating an **“Anytime Spaghetti Fundraiser Dinner”** for the Petro Mobile Chapel. Here's how it works: People can buy a ticket for \$5.00. All of that \$5.00 goes directly to the Mobile Chapel project. Then people can take their ticket to the Iron Skillet Restaurant, located inside the Petro Travel Plaza **ANYTIME** and enjoy an “All You Can Eat” Spaghetti Dinner for just \$3.00. In doing this, the Transport for Christ staff doesn't have to find a hall, prepare the food and designate a certain date & time for people to come and eat. It's also a bargain for those who buy the tickets because you are getting an All-You-Can-Eat Spaghetti dinner for a total of \$8.00 which includes the soup and salad bar. The regular menu price for just a spaghetti dinner is \$9.99 (and it's not all-you-can-eat).

As a supporting church of the Petro Mobile Chapel, we ask our congregation to buy tickets for this fundraiser. There are 3 ways to purchase tickets: see Cindy Knight or any Mobile Chapel Staff member or purchase your ticket right at the Iron Skillet cashier.
